<b>Content</b>	The project provides in-depth information about acids, bases, titrations, and neutralization reactions and/or demonstrates that the student has comprehensive knowledge of acids and bases.	The project includes essential information about acids, bases, titrations, and neutralization reactions and/or demonstrates that the student has basic knowledge of acids and bases.	The project includes basic information about acids, bases, titrations, and neutralization reactions, but there are one to two factual errors.	There is no information provided about acids, bases, titrations, and neutralization reactions, or there are three or more factual errors.
<b>Attractiveness</b>	The project uses font, color, graphics, language, effects, etc. to enhance the attractiveness of the submission.	The project uses font, color, graphics, language, effects, etc. which have no impact on the attractiveness of the submission.	The project uses font, color, graphics, language, effects, etc., but these detract from the attractiveness of the submission.	There is no use of font, color, graphics, language, effects, etc. to enhance the attractiveness of the submission.
<b>Mechanics</b>	The project contains no spelling or grammatical errors.	The project contains minor grammatical or spelling errors with no impact on the quality of the project.
