
Introduction

Look for Receding Water

Tsunami Warning Signs	
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	Look for Receding Water If the water recedes suddenly, you must run to higher ground. Do not wait. Get to a higher place, and get there quickly.

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Watch Fleeing Animals



Animals have a strange sense of detecting when danger is approaching. If you see the wildlife suddenly moving to higher ground, something is wrong.



Listen for Warning Sirens



Many areas surrounding the Pacific Ocean have a warning system of sirens. If you hear these sirens, it is time to get to higher ground.
