


Remember that Virginia is one of the states that has an income tax, so you also have to file this form by May 1. Unlike the federal income tax forms, there is only one form that everyone fills out, Form 760.

It's a relatively simple process, but you'll need your completed federal income tax forms to fill out the form.


Filling out a tax form isn't a lot of fun but knowing how to do it yourself (and do it correctly) can save you money as well as help you determine if a tax preparer made any mistakes.

Before we go through the form, download a copy so you can follow along.










Let's say you're getting a refund. Would you rather file electronically and receive it in one week, or use a paper form and have to wait four weeks! Remember how we talked about getting your refund directly deposited to your account or getting a check? It takes an additional two weeks to get a check.

So, if you file a paper form and get a check, it will take about six weeks for you to get your refund, while if you file electronically and have it deposited directly into your account, it will take one week. It's your decision.
