

### Instructions


### Proverb #1



A chick that will grow into a cock can be spotted the very day it hatches.




### **Preview**



Okonkwo fears that Nwoye will not grow to be a strong leader in his family or the tribe.




### Proverb #2



A child's fingers are not scalded by a piece of hot yam which its mother puts into its palm.





Okonkwo's attempt to justify his actions which led him to disobey the Oracle of the Hills and the Caves.




### Proverb #3



When mother-cow is chewing grass its young ones watch its mouth.





Okonkwo tries to soothe Obierika's frustration with his own son.




### Proverb #4
