


Multiple Choice Question 1




Where does Victor go to create a mate for the creature?

Multiple Choice Question 2




Why does Victor decide to destroy the female creation before he brings her to life?




What happens to Victor after he dumps the remains of the creature's companion in the sea?




After Victor is freed from prison and sets out for Geneva, what does he tell Elizabeth?








Fearing that he may die before capturing the creature, what does Victor initially ask Walton to do?


