


## IGNOMINIOUS

### IMPROMPTU

**DEFINITION:** *done with little or no preparation beforehand* 

**PART OF SPEECH:** *adjective* 

**USED IN A SENTENCE:** *My impromptu party went very well because I keep supplies at my house.*


### IRREPRESSIBLE

**DEFINITION:** *difficult or impossible to control or restrain* 

**PART OF SPEECH:** *adjective* 

**USED IN A SENTENCE:** *The horse was irrepressible once he broke into a gallop.* 





## POSTHUMOUSLY

**DEFINITION:** *occurring after one's death* 

**PART OF SPEECH:** *adjective* 

**USED IN A SENTENCE:** *We found out about the severity of his illness posthumously.*
