


IGNOMINIOUS

DEFINITION: *done with little or no preparation beforehand*

PART OF SPEECH: *adjective*

USED IN A SENTENCE: *My impromptu party went very well because I keep supplies at my house.*


IRREPRESSIBLE

DEFINITION: *difficult or impossible to control or restrain*

PART OF SPEECH: *adjective*

USED IN A SENTENCE: *The horse was irrepressible once he broke into a gallop.*





POSTHUMOUSLY

DEFINITION: *occurring after one's death*

PART OF SPEECH: *adjective*

USED IN A SENTENCE: *We found out about the severity of his illness posthumously.*
