


Animal Farm: Vocabulary (Chapter 6)





INTERMEDIARY

DEFINITION:

one that acts as an agent between persons or things

PART OF SPEECH:

noun

USED IN A SENTENCE:

His sister acted as an intermediary between him and his mother in the fight.





MALIGNITY

DEFINITION:

an act or a feeling of great malice


PART OF SPEECH:

noun

USED IN A SENTENCE:

After she wrecked his car, Jack gave Susan a look of intense malignity.





PROCURE

DEFINITION:

to get by special effort; to obtain


PART OF SPEECH:

verb

USED IN A SENTENCE:

She was able to procure an A by studying intently for the English test.





QUARRY

DEFINITION:

an open excavation or pit from which stone is obtained by digging, cutting, or blasting


PART OF SPEECH:

noun

USED IN A SENTENCE:

The limestone on the kitchen floor came from the local quarry.





VAGUE

DEFINITION:

indistinctly felt, perceived, understood, or recalled

PART OF SPEECH:

adjective

USED IN A SENTENCE:

She had a vague memory of reading before she fell asleep.
