


Animal Farm: Vocabulary (Chapter 7)





CAPITULATE

DEFINITION:

to give up; to remove resistance


PART OF SPEECH:

verh

USED IN A SENTENCE:

After hours of arguing, he capitulated his stance on the issue.





COUNTENANCE

DEFINITION:

appearance, especially the expression of the face


PART OF SPEECH:

noun

USED IN A SENTENCE:

The question left him with a puzzled countenance.





DECREE

DEFINITION:

an authoritative order that has the force of law


PART OF SPEECH:

noun

USED IN A SENTENCE:

The decree states that all bicycle riders must wear helmets.





PRETEXT

DEFINITION:

a professed purpose or excuse


PART OF SPEECH:

noun

USED IN A SENTENCE:

She was eavesdropping on the conversation while she was in the room on the pretext of collecting trash.





STUPEFIED

DEFINITION:

struck with surprise or shock

PART OF SPEECH:

adjective

USED IN A SENTENCE:

She was stupefied by the sudden appearance of the giant spider on her notebook.
