

DEFINITION:

agreeable after an disagreement


PART OF SPEECH:

adjective

USED IN A SENTENCE:

CONFER

DEFINITION:

to bestow upon


PART OF SPEECH:

verb

USED IN A SENTENCE:

She was asked to confer a medal of bravery upon the soldier for his heroics.





MACHINATION

DEFINITION:

a crafty scheme


PART OF SPEECH:

noun

USED IN A SENTENCE:

The crook rubbed his hands together in delight at the plan of his machination.





LAMENTATION

DEFINITION:

a cry of sorrow or grief


PART OF SPEECH:

noun

USED IN A SENTENCE:

We knew who the daughter of the deceased was by her lamentation at the funeral.





SURMOUNT

DEFINITION:

to be above or on top of

PART OF SPEECH:

verb

USED IN A SENTENCE:

The chimney surmounts the roof of the house.
