





Take a few moments to read the poem "Flint" by Christina Rossetti. This poem is filled with similes. Once you have finished reading the poem, click *NEXT*.





These highlights show all of the similes in "Flint" by Christina Rossetti. Remember, a simile is a statement which compares two unlike things using the words "like" or "as." In this poem, the first three lines are all similes because Rossetti compares these precious stones to something of a similar color.
