

#### Introduction

#### **Design Theme and Template**




You should first choose a design theme for the magazine. It may help to look at other examples of high school literary magazines online. You can also look at popular digital magazines to see how they implement themes in their periodicals. In creating a theme, you should consider the following questions:

- What colors will the magazine use?
- Will the design look antique or modern?
- What fonts will the magazine use?
- Will all of the pages contain the same design elements?



#### Front Cover Design




You should design the cover of the digital literary magazine to reflect the works inside. The cover design should be well-organized, clear, and attractive. In creating the front cover design, you should consider the following questions:

- Will you use original graphics or copyright-safe clip art or photos?
- How do the images you select reflect the research papers included in the literary magazine?
- What date will you include on the cover?
- What title will you include on the cover?



#### **Back Cover Design**



Just like the back cover of a book, the back cover of your literary magazine should provide a synopsis of the materials inside. The back cover should also include a graphic layout that coordinates with the front cover design. In creating the back cover design, you should consider the following questions:

- How will you describe the literary magazine?
- Which images will coordinate with what your team has placed on the cover?
