

Making the Future Tense



To make the future tense, conjugate *aller* and then add the infinitive.




Example One



For example, take a moment to look at the sentence, "I am going to dance." First, determine the correct conjugated form of aller for *I am going*. The answer is *je vais*. Then, add the infinitive of the verb, *to dance*, which is *danser*. Therefore, your sentence is, "Je vais danser."








