<b>Organization</b>	The presentation is organized very effectively. Information is presented in a very logical flow that facilitates understanding of the topic.	The presentation is well organized. <b>Content</b>	The presentation clearly explains with detail and reasoning how the project promotes healthy lifestyles in a community. All information regarding planning, resources, and promotion of the project is accurate and explained in depth.	The presentation clearly explains the project, and reasons are given as to how the project promotes healthy lifestyles in a community. All information regarding planning, resources, and promotion of the project is mostly accurate and explained, but some information is vague or confusing.	The presentation basically explains how the project promotes healthy lifestyles in a community. Many details regarding planning, resources, and promotion of the project are not explained, or information is inaccurate or vague.	The presentation does not clearly explain with any detail or reasoning how the project promotes healthy lifestyles in a community. <b>Design</b>	The design of the presentation is extremely visually appealing. It uses a consistent design theme and effective transitions and/or animations that do not distract. It uses a consistent design theme, and most transitions and/or animations do not distract. The use of colors and graphics contributes to overall understanding of the topic, but not always to good effect.	The design of the presentation is somewhat visually appealing. It uses an inconsistent design theme, and many transitions and/or animations are distracting. The use of color and graphics is generally inappropriate or confusing.	The design of the presentation is not visually appealing or consistent. Elements such as transitions, animations, colors, and/or graphics are lacking or confusing.
