


In this interactivity, click each of the buttons below to learn how marine sanctuaries help preserve the oceans.





Protected areas help stabilize the structure of the local ecosystem. Since no species are removed, it helps to ensure that all species will survive.





Protected areas help to improve local fisheries. These protected areas serve as nurseries for breeding fish and spawning, so fishing stocks and yield will increase in adjacent areas.





Protected areas serve as places for oceanographers to observe life without human interaction. This helps ecologists and oceanographers gain an understanding as to how humans influence the ocean environment.





Protected areas offer places for recreation. Snorkeling, diving, and other water sports draw interest from people. These protected areas serve as vacation destinations!
