

Paranoid Schizophrenia



As the name suggests, paranoid schizophrenia is characterized by paranoid delusions and auditory hallucinations. People might be distrustful, and think people are out to get them. Voices might tell them to change locks on their doors or refuse to turn on any lights.




Catatonic Schizophrenia



Catatonic schizophrenia is marked by periods of frozen, stupor-like states in which people will stand or sit frozen in awkward positions for long periods. These long periods void of movement are followed by excitement with rapid movement and speech.



Disorganized Schizophrenia



This type of schizophrenia is characterized by bizarre behavior and disorganized speech and thoughts. Speech may seem incoherent and sound fragmented. This jumbled speech pattern is also called "word salad." Behavior is either absent of emotion or marked by very inappropriate emotions. One minute someone with disorganized schizophrenia can be unresponsive, and the next giddy and giggling.
