

Tips for Viewing and Navigating Review Interactivities Virginia and United States History

Throughout the course, you will find interactivities used to review content. Most review interactivities follow a similar layout. In most instances, audio will not be included in the interactivity. This document provides tips for viewing and navigating review interactivities.

Instructions and Player Buttons

All review interactivities include **player buttons** to control navigation. **Instructions** on how to answer the review questions are included in the interactivity.

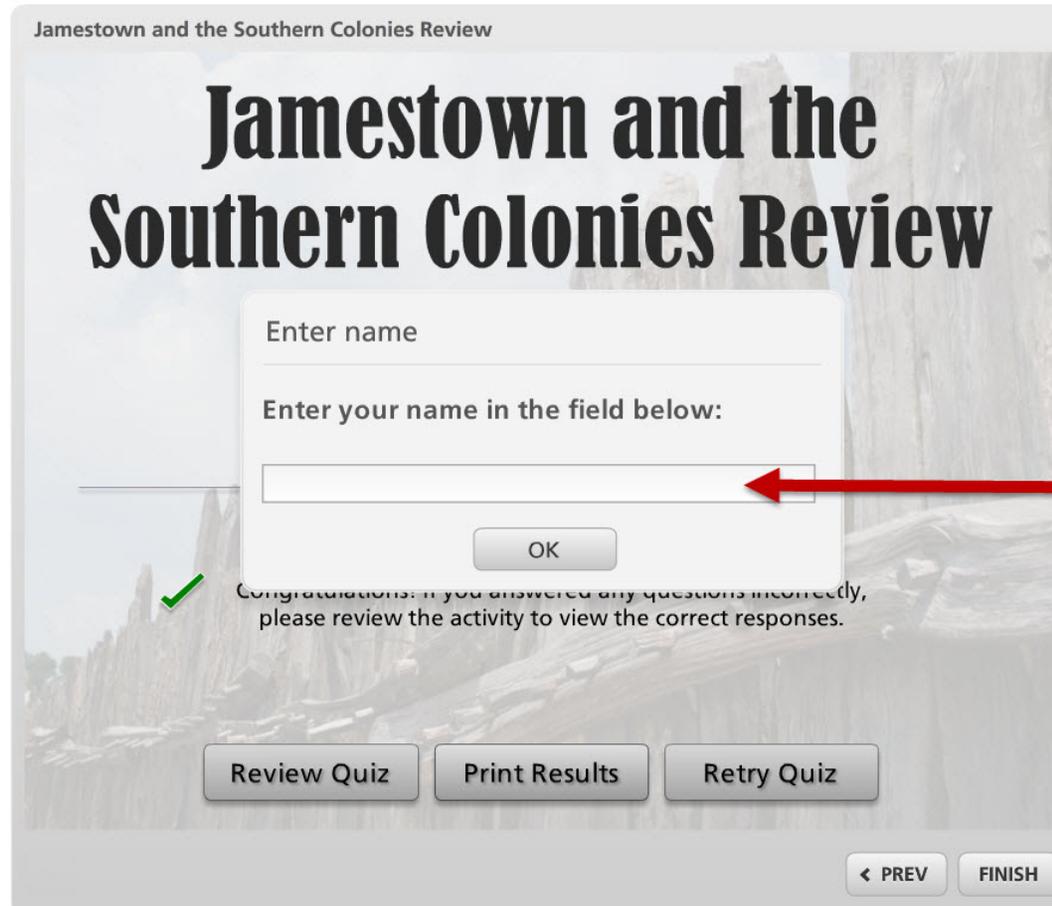

How to View and Print the Review Interactivity Results

Upon clicking the **Print Results** button, you will be prompted to enter your name in the blank field. Click the **OK** button to view the results page.
