

## Tips for Viewing and Navigating Review Interactivities World History and Geography to 1500 A.D. (C.E.)

Throughout the course, you will find interactivities used to review content. Most review interactivities follow a similar layout. In most instances, audio will not be included in the interactivity. This document provides tips for viewing and navigating review interactivities.

### Title Slide

All review interactivities include a title slide. Click the **Next** button to start the review.



#### Submitting a Question

A variety of question types are used in review interactivities. Once you have answered a question, click the **Submit** button to check your answer. The example below shows a **multiple-choice** question.

After clicking the **Submit** button, you will receive corrective feedback. Click the **Continue** button to view the next question.



### The Results Slide

All review interactivities include a **results slide**, which appears when all of the questions have been answered. The results slide contains your score and options to review the quiz, retry the quiz, print the results, or exit the quiz. The example below shows a **results slide**.

### How to View and Print the Review Interactivity Results

Upon clicking the **Print Results** button, you will be prompted to enter your name in the blank field. Click the **OK** button to view the results page.



### How to Exit a Review Interactivity

All review interactivities are set to open in a new browser tab. To exit a review interactivity, simply close the browser tab by click the “x” located in the corresponding tab. Additionally, all interactivities have an **Exit** button that can be used to exit the review interactivity.
