Directions for Authentic Assessments

Each module has an authentic assessment. The intent of this assignment is for students to put together all of the information they have learned in a particular module and demonstrate their mastery of the content. Each authentic assessment has a grading rubric or a checklist for students to view prior to completing the assignment.
