

Module 9: World War II

Topic 4 Application: United Nations Radio News Report

For this assignment you will travel back in time. Your job is to create a radio news report promoting the newly created United Nations in 1945. You will create a script for a radio announcer to read over the air during this time period. Your script should include the following:

- Facts about countries that are joining the U.N.
- Where the U.N. is going to be located
- How the U.N. is going to help solve the world's problems
- How the U.N. will be different from the League of Nations

Your radio news report should only be one page in length. Remember, this report should be written in a positive tone, promoting this worldwide organization. If outside resources are used to complete this assignment, please submit a Works Cited document. You may need to conduct research for other information to include in your script, and you will need to properly cite any external resources that you use. If you need assistance, visit the Developmental Module for information on citing any resources that you used.

After you've prepared your script, you should use audio recording software provided to you by your school or free audio recording software available online, such as [Audacity](#).
